The positions require the ability to work in a fast-paced environment and to collaborate with other student services.

Successful applicants must have excellent clinical skills, strong organizational skills, exceptional interpersonal skills and ability to effectively interact with other campus agencies. In addition to looking for generalists, due to the needs of our student population, we are particularly interested in individuals who have special training, interest and or experience in behavioral health, sports psychology, and/or working with African American/Black student populations.

The Counseling Center provides timelimited treatment, assessment, outreach, and crisis intervention to the campus community. The Center is part of the Division of Student Affairs and has an APA-accredited psychology internship program.
