Trainees are provided extensive supervision with senior clinicians working in a wide range of treatment modalities, a continual case conference on the application of psychodynamic thinking to college mental health practice, a weekly seminar on a broad range of topics, access to in-service presentations and peer supervision groups and other professional development opportunities.
