Position Title: Director of Clinical Services

Position Description / Job Duties

Lewis and Clark College is seeking an energetic administrator and mental health clinician to serve as the Director of Clinical Services in the Counseling Service. This is a full-time, 9.5-month position. The Director oversees the day-to-day clinical operations of the Counseling Service, supervises most clinical counseling staff, and supervises front desk operations. The Director is an active and positive member of the Counseling Service Leadership Team, which also includes the Chief Psychologist and the Associate Director for Training. This team sets goals and assesses outcomes for the Counseling Service. The Director for Clinical Services also provides direct clinical services to a caseload of student clients.

Required Qualifications

- Master's degree in psychology, counseling, social work, or closely related discipline.
- Demonstrated sensitivity and commitment to multicultural issues, and proven ability to counsel and support diverse individuals and groups.
- Licensed as a psychologist, social worker, counselor, or marriage and family therapist by the state of Oregon, or eligible for such licensure by the start of employment.
- Minimum of three years experience providing clinical services in a college mental health setting
- Strong communication and collaboration skills
- Strong clinical and supervision skills

Preferred Qualifications

- Doctorate in psychology, counseling, social work, or closely related discipline
- Prefer five years of experience in the delivery and/or administration of mental health services
- Licensed as psychologist in the state of Oregon, or eligible for such licensure by the start of employment.
