Clinical Services (85%)

- Provide individual, group, and emergency counseling services to RUSVM students.
- Direct clinical services will account for approximately 65% of total hours.
- Develop and deliver a variety of outreach programming activities on campus.
- Provide clinical oversight of the Counseling Center in the absence of the Director of the Counseling Center.
- Provide consultation to faculty and staff, as directed.
- Engage in active case management, as needed.
- Develop psychoeducational materials.
- Ability to effectively manage clients and balance multiple priorities.
- Work with the team to develop and improve the Counseling Center's technology and communication, as directed.
- Knowledge of and ability to protect and maintain the client's right to privacy and confidentiality, including ability to comply with all legal regulations and professional standards in this area.
- Adhere to the ethical and legal standards of professional practice and behavior relevant to the field of training and licensure.
