Position Description:

The Counseling Center Staff Therapist provides mental health and wellness services for the Syracuse University student population. As with all Counseling Center staff therapists, this position will be responsible for providing generalist mental health services including the provision of short-term therapy, group therapy, consultation, educational/preventative outreach programming, and participation in the Center's on-call rotation.

Specific responsibilities as the Triage therapist will include provision of crisis/walk-in services for approximately 20 hours per week and will involve working closely with the Health Center, our wellness partners, and other departments across campus to coordinate triage and crisis intervention services. While this position is oriented to triage and crisis intervention, a small individual therapy caseload may be maintained in addition to the ability to lead one therapy group per week.

Staff therapists have the opportunity to participate on a variety of Counseling Center teams and committees. The staff therapist is expected to be an active member within the Division of Enrollment and Student Experience and represents the Counseling Center at a variety of events and collaborates with colleagues across the university to provide mental health programming and education.

Minimum Requirements:

- Master's degree, or higher, in a mental health discipline (e.g., clinical or counseling psychology, social work, marriage and family therapy, or counselor education).
- Must be licensed or licensed eligible within the state of New York.

Desired Qualifications:

- Experience providing clinical services to culturally diverse client population required.

- Experience with crisis intervention and the ability to conduct risk assessments and manage potentially high risk clients required.
- Experience with conducting triage and management of short-term mental health interventions.
- Experience providing group therapy preferred.
- Experience with trauma informed care, substance abuse treatment preferred but not required.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills required.
- Excellent time management skills.
- Experience working with college students preferred but not required.
