Essential Functions

- Provide clinical screening, intake, individual and group mental health counseling, and crisis intervention to enrolled UT Tyler students. This may require travel to satellite campuses.
- Contribute to campus wellness through education and training by coordinating, designing and implementing outreach programming on mental, emotional, and other health topics to faculty, staff, and students (including all campuses and on-line only students), and the local community. Build collaborative relationships across departments, divisions, and colleges across campus to provide outreach and activities reducing mental health stigma.
- Consult with faculty, staff, students, CARE Team, mental health professionals, and medical personnel as needed. May provide supervision to graduate or LPC interns.
- Participate in departmental efforts to evaluate and continuously improve service provision.

Required Qualifications

- Master's or Doctoral degree in counseling, psychology, social work, or related field.
- One year mental health field experience
- Licensure in the state of Texas at the time of start date. Acceptable licenses: LPC-Intern, LPC, LMFT, LCSW or Licensed Psychologist.

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience working in a college or university counseling center.
- Experience developing and delivering psycho-educational presentations and other outreach programs to small and large groups of people.
- Experience providing single session/brief therapy.
